Introducing Three Changes

The Avenue of Flags has been completely revamped, allowing flags to be flown in the front of the cemetery – 81 flags east and 81 flags west of the main entrance.

Why the change?

- Vehicle/pedestrian safety
- Increased visibility
- Specific flags easier to find
- Cost effective for family participation
- Reduced maintenance

Current participants can continue participating for \$20 for a 5 year period.

The cost for new participants will be \$50 for a 5 year period.

Flags will be flown from shortly before Memorial Day until July 5th, from September 11th thru the 3rd full weekend in September, and then again for Veterans Day (weather permitting)
